

Continuing Professional Development Program CPDP

Requirements for International Observers

The following requirements must be met prior to acceptance:

- Copy of curriculum vitae in English;
- Sufficient proficiency in spoken and written English language to meet the criteria of International Services;
- Commitment to meet the health and safety requirements applicable to The Methodist Hospital employees;
- Proof of compliance with immunization requirements. All documents must be translated into English;
- Mandatory purchase of major medical and liability insurance during time of observation; and
- International Visitor/Observer Form and Full Liability and Release Form and Observer Agreement must be completed and signed upon arrival at the International Services office.

Privileges include:

- Strictly observer status without direct patient contact in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by the Texas Medical Board;
- Visitor's identification badge to be issued upon clearance by the International Services office; and
- A certificate of participation will be provided to those observing for two weeks or more.

Cost:

- The cost to participate in the observership program is \$500 for a two week program and/or \$750 for a one month observership.
